CONCEALED WEAPON LICENSE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

NEW APPLICANT/RENEWING APPLICANT:

1. Complete Application Packet.
2. Packets may be returned/submitted to the Red Bluff Police Department on Monday – Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Please make sure your contact phone number is listed on the application.
3. You will be called to schedule your appointment and appointments will be scheduled for Thursdays only at 9:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m. or 2:00 p.m.
4. Please bring the following with you to your appointment/interview with the Lieutenant or his designee & be prepared to complete additional paperwork from Department of Justice:

****For NEW Applicants****

- *Completed DOJ Application - (unless turned in to RBPD, in advance)*
- *Payment of fees –*
 - \$17.00 (payable to RBPD); the balance of \$169.00 to be paid upon approval and completion of your firearms handgun safety class;(cash or check only)
- *Present the weapons you want listed on your permit for verification.* All weapons must be registered to the applicant or spouse. **The weapons must be unloaded and in a locked case when presented.**
- *Valid California ID or driver's license.*
- *Live scan (aka Fingerprinting)* - Upon completion of your interview with the Lieutenant or his designee, you will be given a live scan form for your fingerprinting. (You will need to contact the Tehama County Sheriff's Office at 530-529-7940 to schedule that appointment. Please bring the completed portion of that form back to RBPD, when your live scan is finished.)

After your permit application and live scan results have been received and reviewed, you will be given written notification of eligibility approval or denial, in the form of a Good Faith letter.

If you are approved, you will take your written notification to a Red Bluff Police Department approved Firearm Instructor (see attached list) for your firearm training. Upon the successful completion of your firearms training, please bring to us an original copy of your Firearm Training Certificate of Completion.

****The Red Bluff Police Department will not accept training certificates from firearms instructors not listed on our approved Firearms Instructors List (see attached). Also, we will not accept training certificates that have been issued prior to the issuance of a Good Faith letter. ****

After your firearm certificate has been received and reviewed by the Chief of Police, you will receive your new CCW permit/license and pay the balance of your permit fee of \$169.00, for new permits.

****For Renewal Applicants****

- *Completed DOJ Application*
- *\$44.00 payable to RBPD (cash or check) & \$52.00 payable to State of California (personal or cashier check) at the time of your scheduled appointment.*
- *Present the weapons you want listed on your permit for verification. All weapons must be registered to the applicant or spouse. **The weapons must be unloaded and in a locked case when presented.***
- *Valid California ID or driver's license.*
- *Firearm Class Completion Certificate with one of our Approved Instructors (see attached list)*

After all items are received and your interview has been completed with Lt. Flowerdew, our agency will process your renewal and you will be contacted once it is approved by the Chief of Police.
